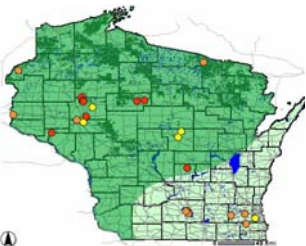

## Wisconsin NatureMapping Data From June 2006

- 188** Total NatureMapping Observations  
(compared to 255 in May)
- 6.26** Observations/day  
(compared to 8.22 in May)
- 598** Animals observed  
(during those 188 total NM observations)
- 3.18** Animals present per observation
- 15** New NatureMappers registered  
(during June 2006, 631 NM-ers total)

Canada Goose*	248
Barn Swallow	20
American Goldfinch	16
White-tailed Deer	14
Northern Green Frog	13

\* During one observation period, 240 geese were observed.

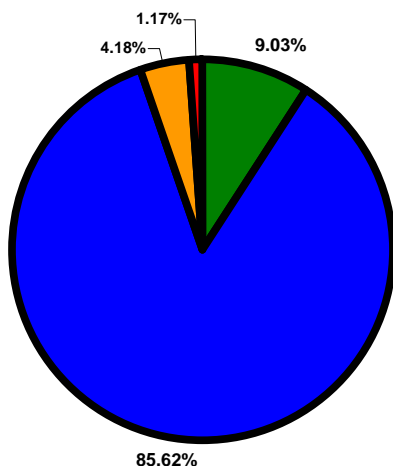

## Types of animals observed, Wisconsin NatureMapping, June 2006



**Birds – 85.62%**  
**Mammals – 9.03%**  
**Amphibians – 4.18%**  
**Reptiles – 1.17%**
